ENTRY POINT: Show your project all about me.

MATHS: To understand number from 1-30. Count and recognise. To make number bonds to 10 and to 20. Using addition up to 10 and subtraction up to 10. Recognise and make shapes and patterns. Recognise the difference between 'teen' number (13,14,15 etc) and 'ty' numbers (20, 30, 40 etc).



ENGLISH: Looking at words around the classroom. Writing labels and captions. Autobiography: write about yourself. Recount – retell the events in order. All children are learning phonics, using their sounds to decode and spell. Please support your children learning their high frequency words.



SCIENCE: Who am I? Name parts of the body, inside and out. What do these parts do – heart, lung, stomach. How are our families the same? Who do we look alike?



COMPUTING PROJECT: Learning to use the iPad to take photos and a video. In the ICT suite, log on, log off and type your own name. Make labels.

ART: Draw a self portrait looking in a mirror. Using half a portrait, complete the picture. Create cubist art inspired by Picasso using our own faces. Look at and create portraits of famous sports athletes for Black History Month.



GEOGRAPHY: Learning about where we live: Barking, England, UK and where we fit in the world. What places do we belong to? What do we see in our local area.
