**HOST NATION:
GREECE**

ENTRY POINT: We held a story telling session.
(Tuesday 1st September)

MATHS: In Maths we will be looking at numbers up to 1000 and place value as well as addition and subtraction. The children will learn to count in steps of 2,3,4, 5 and 10 from any number forward and backward. Recognise the place value digit in a three-digit number. Use place value and number facts to solve problems. Solve problems with addition and subtraction. Apply knowledge of mental and written methods.



ENGLISH: In English we will be combining our learning in History and Geography to write a variety of genres including recounts, traditional tale, myths and legends.

We will also be reading a variety of traditional tales, myths and legends.

We will be giving 15 spellings for the children to learn over 2 weeks. This will be given out every second Thursday along with homework.

HISTORY: We will find out about myths and legends from different times in the past.
We will learn how to create our own legend about someone we know.
We will learn about Ancient Egyptians.



GEOGRAPHY: We will learn about the countries and cultures linked to the stories we have read. We will create a mythical land map.

ART: We will design and make our own Greek clay pots.

We will design and make our own dream catchers and make puppets.



SOCIETY: We will learn about fairytales and fables and the lessons they teach us.

We will explore modern version of fairytales.
We will look at who we think of as 'heroes' today.
