SCIENCE.

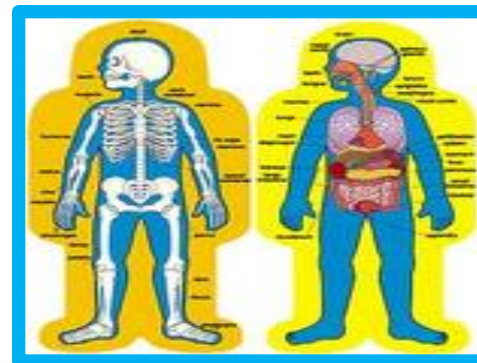

HOST NATION:  
Brazil

**Angles**-Identify what angles are. Arrange angles in ascending or descending order. Identify angles on geometrical shapes and the number of sides with the number of angles. Make angles using paper strips.

**Perpendicular and parallel lines**-State that perpendicular lines are two straight lines that meet at a right angle. Identify and draw perpendicular lines on square grid paper and in everyday objects. Identify, name and draw parallel lines on square grid paper or everyday objects.

**Area and perimeter**- Understand area of a shape and standard unit for representing area. Find area of a shape: rectangles and composite shapes. Find the perimeter of shapes. Compare areas and
