Punctuality and Lateness

At Eastbury, we work closely with our parents and carers to promote high standards of attendance, punctuality, good behaviour and respect from all our children. Please could all parents and carers therefore ensure that children are in school before 8:55am (When the playground gates close). The school gates open at 8:45am so that children can come into class and prepare for the start of the day. Children who are consistently late miss valuable learning time which will hold back their progress. Parents should also be punctual in picking up their children from school at the end of the day. This is 3:00pm for Key Stage 1 children and 3:15pm for Key Stage 2. Reception parents can pick their children up through the main school entrance from 2:50pm, leaving plenty of time to reach the main playground to pick up older siblings on time. Being picked up late can be upsetting for the children. Please be aware that children who are late to be collected from school may be taken to the Eagles after school club and, as a result, parents will be charged the £10 per child fee.
