Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will focus on:

- Sharing, taking turns and finding ways to solve problems with our friends.
- Building confidence to talk to others about our own needs, wants and opinions.
- Transition from Nursery to Reception.



Communication and Language

We will learn to:

- Maintain attention and focus during activities.
- Understand and respond to more complex instructions and questions.
- Use talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next.
- Use a range of vocabulary to convey meaning.
- Use language to imagine and recreate roles.
- Use a range of tenses.



Physical Development (PD)

We will focus on:

- Travelling with confidence and skill around, under, through balancing and climbing equipment.
- Holding a pencil and using scissors correctly.
- Forming letters correctly.
- Becoming increasingly independent with our self-help skills.
- Showing an understanding of the need for safety when tackling new challenges.



Literacy

We will use the following core texts to support our literacy work:

- *A range of wild animal and transport non-fiction books.*
- *Elmer, Dear zoo and Monkey puzzle.*
- *Walking through the jungle, The train ride, Duck in the truck and Titch.*

We will focus on:

- Writing our name and using letters to communicate meaning.
- Blending and segmenting words.
- Linking sounds to letters.
- Identifying the initial sound in words.
- Knowing that print carries meaning.
- Beginning to read and write simple words.



Maths

We will learn to:

- Recognise numbers to 10 and beyond.
- Match the numeral to the correct number of objects.
- Count out objects from a larger group.
- Estimate how many objects there are and check by counting them.
- Name, recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes.
- Order objects by length and height.
- Use positional language.
