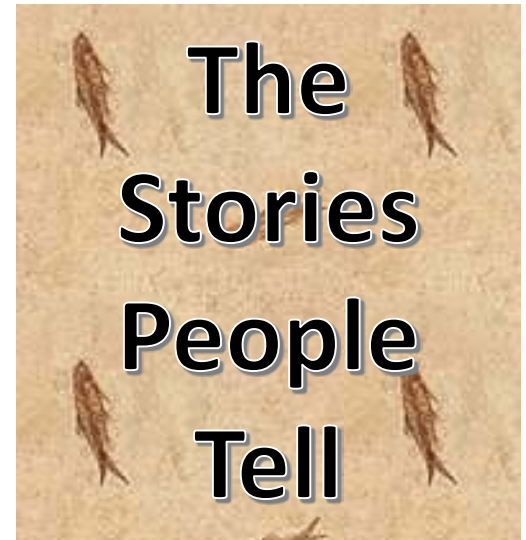

HOST NATION:  
GREECE

ENTRY POINT: We held a story telling session.

**MATHS:** In Maths we will be looking at numbers up to 1000 and place value as well as addition and subtraction. The children will learn to count in steps of 2,3,4, 5 and 10 from any number forward and backward. Recognise the place value digit in a three-digit number. Use place value and number facts to solve problems. Solve problems with addition and subtraction. Apply knowledge of mental and written methods.



**ENGLISH:** In English we will be learning to write stories with a familiar setting. We learn how to use noun phrases and punctuate sentences correctly. We will also learn how to an explanation text about the life cycle of a frog.



**HISTORY:** We will find out about myths and legends from different times in the past. We will learn how to create our own legend about someone we know. We will learn about Ancient Egyptians.



**GEOGRAPHY:** We will learn about the countries and cultures linked to the stories we have read. We will create a mythical land map.

**ART/DT:** We will design and make our own Greek clay pots. We will design and make our own dream catchers and make puppets.



**PSHE:** We will learn about ourselves and others. We discuss what makes the children individual and how they are different from others
