Friday 14th July (2C and 2D)



HOST NATION: Spain

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MATHS:

Time- Reading and telling the time in 15 minute intervals

Problem Solving – solve practical maths problems using the above learning.

Direction and movement- looking at quarter turns, clockwise and anticlockwise.

Data handling- Collecting and representing information and interpreting data.



ENGLISH:

We will be learning to write a fantasy story set in space. Children will be focusing on using the correct tense and ensuring there is a quest, problem and resolution. We will also be learning to write an information text about chocolate



PE:

Children will be inventing and trialing a range of outdoor games. They will also have the opportunity to participate in some athletics activities.



Music:

The children will appreciate a range of different styles and have the chance to compose their own pieces.

PSHE:

Our focus this term will be health and relationships. The children will learn about how to keep safe under the context of hazardous substances in the home. The children will also learn about the similarities and differences between male and females, leading on to getting ready for their transition to year 3.

History/ geography:

In Geography, the children will be using maps and atlas to locate holiday destinations and identify cities and landmarks. They will also plan travel routes and transport options.

ART/DT:

In Art, the children will use a variety of materials and processes including photography and sand sculpture.



ICT:

The children will be using cameras and editing software to present information.
