**SCIENCE**

**History:** History will be enjoyed through the IPC topic of Champions for Change. We will learn about democracy, governments and how technology has shaped our future.




**COMPUTING PROJECT:** We will research and retrieve information to answer questions and provide knowledge about our topic.
